****Supply List****

While there is no specific school supply list for high school students beyond notebooks and writing instruments, individual teachers and classes may require additional supplies. Students will be advised in their classrooms at the start of each trimester of any additional supplies needed.

To all students taking Mathematics courses: The WHS Mathematics Department offers the following information regarding calculators. Although smart phones and other devices do have advanced calculator apps, students cannot use their cell phones/computer/iPad/Chromebook during tests and quizzes. Because of this, in order to be successful in the course, a regular scientific calculator is necessary for Intermediate Algebra 1 and Geometry. Once students get to courses Algebra 2 and Statistics, a graphing calculator is required. The Mathematics Department recommends the Texas Instruments TI83+, TI-84 or TI 84+. It is not advised to purchase any other style or type of calculator, as they do not correspond to the curriculum that WHS uses.

To all students enrolled in any of the following courses:

Principles of Physics (POP), Principles of Engineering (POE), Physics: You are required to have a standard size graph-ruled paper composition book on the first day of class.

A college ruled composition book would also work however graphing ruled is best.

For POP and POE you will use the same book.

AP Biology: You are required to have a graph-ruled ONLY (7 1/2" x 9 3/4" size) composition/lab book.

If you are unable to obtain a graph-ruled notebook, check with your teacher before the start of school for new or used ones possibly available for purchase or free.

****LOCKERS****

Once again, lockers have been assigned to Freshmen and Sophomores only, and are available to Juniors and Seniors upon request. Freshmen and Sophomores can find their locker assignments on their schedules or in Infinite Campus.

****Lunch Accounts****

Please access our website (www.cafe110.org) for information including menus, meal pricing, meal benefit application, frequently asked questions, contact information, and lunch account balance/ transaction/ deposit information. Please note that Wordware and SmartSchool are now linked and you can access your family lunch account through either website. Because of this, please be advised that any activity fee payments will now show up on your Wordware transaction report.

You can access Wordware via www.wordwareinc.com. By registering your Wordware family lunch account, you are able to deposit money online including the option for auto-fill, see all deposits and transactions, change your notification amount (currently, notifications will be e-mailed once the account goes negative), and add other users to your account. Your Wordware account only needs to be registered once. There are vending machines located in the hallway that leads to Safari Island that are open 24 hours a day.
