- C. English: 2 credits required. Choose one of the following groups:**
- ☐ English 9A (#100) & English 9B (#101)
 - ☐ Pre-AP English 9A (#127) & Pre-AP English 9B (#128)
- D. Math: You are required to take 2 credits of Math, but may choose 3 credits.**
- ☐ Intermediate Algebra 1A (#320) & Intermediate Algebra 1B (#321)-Choose this if you are in Algebra 8. If you want to take a 3rd Math register for Geometry A (#302)
 - ☐ Geometry A (#302) & Geometry B (#303)- Choose this if you are currently in Intermediate Algebra. If you want to take a 3rd Math register for Algebra 2A (#304)
 - ☐ Algebra 2A (#304) & Algebra 2B (#305)- Choose this if you are currently in Geometry. If you want to take a 3rd Math register for either Trigonometry (#306) or Pre-Calculus (#307)
- E. Electives: Choose electives to total 15 classes. Don't forget your graduation requirements.**
- F. Alternatives: Choose 2 alternative classes in case something doesn't work.**
