Hello ISD ONE10 Parents.

The Governor announced today at his 2:00 p.m. press conference that he is implementing a new executive order.

This executive order has the following provisions:

- There is a two week "Stay at Home" order for all Minnesota residents with the exception of essential workers or essential travel starting March 27th at 11:59 p.m. through April 10th at 11:59 p.m.
- Minnesota schools are expected to educate students through a Distance Learning model from March 30 through April 30, 2020. There will be no school for students on May 1 and May 4 to allow for staff to return to the school buildings and prepare for the students to return to school in the buildings starting May 5, 2020.
- This new executive order is subject to change if new information of the spread of COVID-19 (coronavirus) warrants a change in this protocol.

What this means for us at ISD ONE10:

- The ISD ONE10 Distance Learning model will be conducted by ONE10 staff starting on March 30 and run through April 30, 2020
- All students are expected to complete the tasks and classroom expectations as described by their teacher.

We understand this new style of education will be a learning curve for all of us. We are so thankful for the parent support and partnership on this Distance Learning journey. It is understandable that students receiving their education at home will come with challenges and we want to support you where we can.
